About this Agreement:

Luzerne County Community College ("Luzerne") and Misericordia University ("Misericordia") have agreed to a correlation of curricula for students in the Associate in Science Exercise Science at Luzerne and desire to complete the Bachelor of Science Health Science at Misericordia. Subject to the terms of this Agreement a student who satisfactorily completes the requirements of the AS degree at Luzerne with a 2.0 grade point average will be granted admission to Misericordia and will have earned credits accepted in transfer based on the agreement equivalency.

The following terms and conditions shall apply:

- 1) A minimum of 120 credits are required for an undergraduate degree at Misericordia.
- 2) Transfer students must earn a minimum of 2.0 credits at Misericordia.
- 3) Students must maintain a 2.0 GPA in the major and an overall 2.0 GPA to graduate.
- 4) This Agreement is a guide only. Misericordia cannot guarantee the needed courses will be offered in a given semester.
- 5) Misericordia estimates a student will be able to earn the BS in two (2) years (minimum of four semesters).
- 6) The student must meet all requirements of the Dual Admission Agreement noted above.
- 7) The student shall choose the recommended elective courses and course sequence as shown in Attachment A.
- 8) The student must not attend another institution of higher education between Luzerne graduation and Misericordia enrollment.


If the above terms and conditions are not met, credit transfer determination will be completed by Misericordia on an individual basis. A course-to-course evaluation will also be completed for all students transferring without an earned associate degree.

The Agreement may be terminated by either Luzerne or Misericordia at any time via written notification to the other institution. The termination will go into effect thirty (30) days after receipt of notice to terminate and will not apply to any students who have already begun the Associate Degree program at Luzerne or the Bachelor Degree program at Misericordia.
