MENTAL HEALTH INTERVENTIONS SPECIALIZATION

The Mental Health Interventions Specialization is a 15-credit program that integrates a series of mental health focused coursework. Students can opt to concentrate on children and adolescents (Child Focus) or adults (Adult Focus). The course sequence is parallel across both populations starting with typical and atypical development followed by diagnosis, characteristics and treatment of psychological disorders.

Students can only select one focus (Child or Adult).
